

Kamp Counselor Information

Kidz Kamp would not happen without these selfless souls. For one week, these heroes will eat, sleep and breathe with children. They will return home exhausted, but it will be one of the best experiences in their life.

Kamp Counselor Responsibilities:

- Register for Kidz Kamp. (See the Parent Info/Instruction Sheet for how to register.)
- Ensure that children are supervised at **all** times.
- Ensure children are where they should be when they should be there.
- Participate in & assist with large group Bible Studies each day with children.
- Assist and participate with children as needed.
- Be the mom, dad, motivator, cheerleader, Bible teacher, Scripture memorizer, recreation craft guru, guinea pigs, and counselor for five adoring campers.

Two weeks before Kidz Kamp, all registered counselors, boogers (student leaders) and staff will be sent an information sheet by email. This handbook will give you further information on what to bring to Kamp, responsibilities, a map, and the schedule.

Here are some important things for counselors to know:

- Campers must be supervised at **all** times.
- Check-in begins no earlier than 3 PM and we conclude our week with Worship on Friday after lunch.
- Do not have parents drop off their children at Kidz Kamp without counselors and the Camp Coordinator.
- No knives or other dangerous items.
- Open food containers should not be left in the cabins. Insects and wildlife love to visit the unsuspecting.
- Campers should not bring electronic devices, but counselors are welcome to bring some form of Christian music for the children as long as you adhere to Emmanuel Pines noise policy.
